### Polite reminders

**Uniform Attendance** 

Thank you for ensuring that the children arrive at school in their uniform. A polite reminder that children Children can be dropped off from 08:45 in the morning and should be in school by 09:00. Members of staff are should come to school in full school uniform. For boys, this consists of black school shoes, grey trousers or shorts, white polo shirt and purple jumper. For girls, this consists of black school shoes, grey skirt or pinafore, white polo shirt and purple jumper or cardigan. Summer dresses can also be worn. Long hair should be tied back. Earrings should be studs and must be removed for PE.

PE kits must be brought into school in a gym bag and consist of black shorts or tracksuit bottoms, t-shirt in their house colour and black tracksuit top. (we will be reminding everyone of their houses next week). Should any families be experiencing difficulties in obtaining uniform, please speak to the school office as we do carry spares and second-hand uniform.

As you are all aware, the Government are continuing to ensure that schools address poor attendance. It is imperative that children attend school every day and on time. Our attendance is reviewed on a termly basis by the local authority and any attendance below 90% is closely monitored, with actions taken in accordance with our Attendance Policy. This may include letters home, fines or referrals into the local authority.
