


English


Maths

In Maths this term, we are learning all about addition and subtraction. We will begin by learning to recognise money (coins and notes), with the Year 2's beginning to count money. We will then start to secure our knowledge in addition and subtraction, learning fact families and number bonds.



Science

In Science this term, we are learning about animals, including humans. We will be able to identify, name draw and label the basic parts of the human body and explore which parts of the body are associated with each sense. We will observe, gather and record data to answer scientific questions.



Theme

Our project this term is History. We will be focusing on Mary Seacole and Edith Cavell, two important nurses from the Crimean and Great War. We will explore their backgrounds, how they got into nursing and the impact they had on the profession. We will look at similarities and differences between the two nurses and nursing then and now.
