Term 3

R.E

In RE this term, we will be exploring the Big Question 'What do Christians believe is special about Jesus and the message He brings?' The children will consider what happens after the nativity story, when Jesus is no longer a baby. They will also learn about some of the parables that Jesus told and think about the meaning of these.



Phonics

This term we will continue learning new sounds, blending to read simple words and segmenting the sounds in words to support our writing. We will be learning the sounds:

j, v, w, x, z in (bugs (z), z in (zap), qu.

We will also be learning some high frequency words (or tricky words) to recognise on sight:

he, she, we, me, be, was, my, you, her, they, all, are.

Each Friday the children will bring home a reading activity to practise to support their learning.

Physical Development

In PE the children will be doing football-learning the fundamental skills of passing, control and dribbling.

The children will be working on the correct technique, using the inside of the foot, and the basic understanding of rules in game situations.



We will continue to refine our fine motor skills every day to support our handwriting using tweezers, scissors, dough disco, threading and lots more!

PSHE/RSE

In PSHE this term Rabbit Class will be thinking about relationships with a focus on friendships. We will be answering questions like what makes a good friend and how it feels to have friends.

We will also consider why rules are important and what rules we need to follow in class.

Rabbit Class will continue to use the 'Zones of Regulation' to recognise and understand emotions.
